

## **Important information about Kliffa for parents and adults**

We have compiled a packet of useful information about Kliffa: participation fees, how to contact us and how to prepare for the camp.

### **Camp dates**

23.–26.7. short Kliffa (cub scouts aged between 7 and 9 years, and those spending a shorter time at Kliffa)

23.–30.7. long Kliffa (scouts aged between 10 and 15 years)

23.–31.7. long Kliffa (scouts aged over 15 years)

28.7. Visitors' day

On the camp's Saturday the relatives of the campers can get to know the camp life. More information will be provided during the Spring.

### **Fee**

The fee of the camp depends on the time spent on camp

Short Kliffa 130 €

Long Kliffa 210 €

Day camp price 35 € / day

Scouts aged between 0 and 3 years 0 €

Scouts aged between 4 and 6 years 100 €

A possible stipend will be reduced from the participant's camp fee, as well as any financial support provided by the participant's home unit.

### **Charging**

The camp fee will be charged in one bill after the 16<sup>th</sup> of April, 2018. The bill will be sent as a paper version, via email or as an electronic bill. If you don't receive your bill, you can find it at Kuksa in your personal information.

Non-scout participants can ask for a copy of their Kliffa bill from Kliffa's project office.

The possible stipends will be considered in the charging, as well as any financial support provided by the participant's home unit. The receivers of the stipends will be decided after the participation registration has closed. The board making the decisions on stipends will contact the applicants after the decisions have been made.

To enter the campsite, you have had to pay your camp fee. Furthermore, you have to have paid your membership fee of the Finnish Scouts and Guides.

### **If you have to cancel your participation**

If you cancel your participation, your participation fee will not be returned. In cases of illness, the participant can apply to receive their participation fee back from their insurance company, or through their scouters' insurance.

### **Unchallenged access and health related issues during camp**

Even though we will be spending Kliffa in forest, we will take the accessibility questions and other special needs into close consideration. The program valleys will be accessible to all scouts and the neutrality of sexes will be taken into account during the planning of the camp's services.

Primarily the camp's first-aid personnel will react to health-related issues but there will also be two first aid stations and a camp hospital at Kliffa.

Other specific health and hygiene related issues you should take into account during camp:

- Every participant is required to make sure, that they have a valid tetanus and measles vaccination in place during the camp.
- Contact lenses are forbidden at Kliffa due to the risk of eye inflammation.
- Everybody takes care of their personal medication. Cold-storage for medicines will be available.

During meals we will take into account the participants' special diets – no personal snacks need to be brought to camp!

### **Camp products**
